He works on behalf of clients in the financial services sector (banks, insurers, pension funds) on strategic and quantitative issues closely related to innovation challenges.

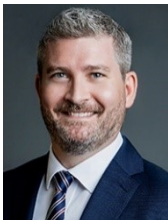
